Association of Fire Districts of the State of New York, Inc. *"Ned Carter" Scholarship.* Four \$1,500 scholarships are available to students who are either related to a firefighter or are themselves firefighters, and are members of The Association of Fire Districts of the State of New York. Boston University *Trustee Scholarship Competition.* A four-year, full-tuition scholarship awarded to 15 students with outstanding academic ability and the potential to inspire fellow students to excel. Trustee scholars typically rank at the top of their class and demonstrate exceptional leadership in their communities and schools. College Sports Recruiting Scholarship. Scholarship of \$1,000 awarded to a college student who best represents a true leader in sports and life. East Los Angeles Community Union *TELACU Scholarship Program.* Applicant must be a first-generation college student from a low-income family and have a minimum GPA of 2.5. Applicant must also be a permanent resident of the state of New York. The program offers a range of individual awards from \$500 - \$7,500. Fairleigh Dickinson University *Full-Tuition Presidential Scholarship.* An annually renewable full-tuition award for four years of study at FDU's Florham Campus or Metropolitan Campus.
