

**BELLMORE-MERRICK CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT  
SENIOR PROM CONTRACT**

Students who participate in prom activities should recognize that they have an obligation to themselves, their classmates and the school community to act in a mature and responsible manner. Attendance at the senior prom should be a positive experience where students exhibit civil behavior, respect for others and mature judgment.

The following are expectations for all prom attendees. This includes all students of the Bellmore-Merrick Central High School District as well as their guests.

Students and guests attending the prom must:

1. Understand that participation in prom activities is a privilege and should be valued.
2. Understand and abide by the rules and regulations that govern all school activities refraining from disorderly, disrespectful, disruptive or insubordinate behaviors.
3. Demonstrate respect for others including school supervisors and staff, catering staff and classmates. Appropriate language must be used at all times.
4. Understand that they may not be in possession of or under the influence of any alcoholic beverages, drugs, narcotic or controlled substance. This applies to all individuals regardless of age. A breathalyzer will be used at the door to resolve issues regarding alcohol consumption. If a student refuses the administration of a breathalyzer test, he/she will be presumed to have consumed alcohol and processed in the same manner as if a positive test result had been obtained and the student will be excluded from the prom, prom-related activities and other school events. **Failure to meet this guideline will result in a suspension from school. The suspension will effectively exclude the student from the graduation ceremony.**
5. Understand that once at the prom, students may not leave the location and re-enter the prom.
6. **Be responsible for their behavior. Students, therefore, who are found to have violated district policy and/or this contract, will face disciplinary actions, including suspension and a loss of privileges such as participation in the graduation ceremony.**
7. Understand that all students will need to inform the school as to how they will be arriving to and departing from the prom, and if they are traveling by limousine or party bus, a list of the prom attendees and their dates who are in the limousine/party bus must be submitted at the time of ticket purchase.
8. Understand that if he/she is bringing a date who is not a Mepham student, the date must complete a prom guest contract and the Mepham student must present the guest contract and a copy of the guest's photo ID when purchasing prom tickets. The guest must present photo ID upon entering the prom.

**Individual students or guests not meeting the guidelines set by the Bellmore-Merrick Central High School District and the school administration will be removed from or denied entrance to the prom. Parents will be notified and arrangements will be made for the student to be sent home at his/her own expense.**
