RELATIONS WITH PARENT ORGANIZATIONS

The Board of Education recognizes and encourages the support and participation of parents-teacher organizations. The Board shall strive to cooperate with the parentteacher associations to achieve their common goal of the best education for the children of the district. The Board and the administration shall attempt to keep these organizations informed of all major developments within the schools, and shall solicit their aid in disseminating the facts to the public at large.

Staff members are encouraged to participate in these groups, and assist the officers/directors of all such organizations in the pursuit of the following goals:

- 1. to involve parents and school personnel in a cooperative and sustained system of activities which will increase the educational opportunities of the children both in school and at home;
- 2. to provide teachers and administrators with viewpoints and share input in regard to student needs and program planning;
- 3. to support and encourage community members to function effectively in a working relationship with parents and other school personnel.
