SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

The audience was advised that the Board of Education will adopt the resolution to present the proposed bond for a vote at its meeting on Monday, October 7, 2013. The bond vote is scheduled for Monday, December 2, 2013. Voting and

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registration will take place in each of the component districts at the same locations and times as in past budget votes and trustee elections. Mr. DeTommaso provided the years the District's building were built and Mr. Smith reviewed the life expectancy the District's buildings. Mr. Smith stated capital improvement work has been performed on District buildings over the years but much as not been done. He then reviewed the proposed work to be done in this bond. He also reviewed the Energy Performance Contract (EPC) and "smart financing".
