V. BELLMORE-MERRICK CHSD ADOPTION OF BUDGET PROPOSITION

A. PROPOSITION NO. 1 – CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Bellmore-Merrick Central High School District, Town of Hempstead, County of Nassau, is authorized to expend the sums in the General Fund Appropriate of one hundred seventy million, one hundred sixty thousand, four hundred six dollars (\$170,160,406) to be raised through taxation in the several districts included with the Central High School District after first deducting the monies available from state aid and other sources.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Nassau BOCES Proposed Administrative Operations Budget for the 2021/22 school year in the amount of twenty-three million, two hundred forty-four thousand, eight hundred nine dollars (\$23,234,089) be, and hereby is, approved by this Board.
