

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974

Resolved that: The Board of Education adopt regulations in compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 which provides for access to student records.

Names and Addresses - Students

Resolved that: the names, addresses and telephone numbers of students and parents are confidential and are not to be released by the district or by any district employee. However, the Principal is authorized to release school and class lists to Parent-Teacher Associations, Parent Faculty Associations and school booster clubs for use by those organizations, and to any group authorized by the District or the Building Principal for the purpose of school or school district public relations.

The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 requires the District to disclose to military recruiters and institutions of higher learning, upon request, the names, addresses and telephone numbers of high school students. Each High School Principal must notify parents of their right and the right of their child to request that the District not release such information without prior written parental consent.
