## **TEXTBOOK PROCEDURES**

Requests for second sets of textbooks by non-public school students will be entertained following submission of the District's designated form. No request for a second set of books for students in grades 9-12 will be granted unless there is medical reason for same.

Students in grades 7 and 8 may submit a request and, if the books are available, the request will be granted. Under no circumstances will new books be purchased unless a medical reason for a second set exists.

The District's physician will have final say in determining the medical need for second sets of books.

This practice is in keeping with the equitable distribution (Education Law §701) of textbooks to District students enrolled in public and non-public schools.

## COMPUTER RELATED LOAN PROCEDURES

In conformity with Education Law §754 and in recognition of the District's responsibility, the non-public schools located in the Bellmore and Merrick communities are to be notified that a deadline date of June 1 of the school year preceding the school year for which computer related requests are being made has been established by the District. Any requests received after that date will be rejected unless a reasonable explanation for the delay is provided.

At no time will a non-public per student allocation exceed the amount of per student state aid provided the District pursuant to Education Law §753.

## Amendment – August 5, 2015

In recognition of the requirements of the Smart Schools Bond Act, the District will set aside an aggregate amount equal to \$250 per student for classroom technology loans to non-public schools within the Bellmore and Merrick communities. (2014-15 BEDS data establishes that number of students at 132.) The deadline date remains June 1 in accordance with previously established computer related loan procedures.
